PART 1 – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1.01 SUMMARY

A. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

1. Install Gough SnoGuard Type SGNL snow guards for slate roofs.
2. Assure proper positioning of snow guards with roof installation.
3. This snow guard hangs on the Nu-Lok galvalume channel system and may be installed new or easily retrofitted.

1.02 SUBMITTALS

- A. PRODUCT DATA: Submit manufacturer's product data & installation instructions.
- B. SHOP DRAWINGS: If not clearly shown on project drawings, submit roof drawing showing locations of all Gough SnoGuard Type SGNL snow guards and attachment spacing.
- C. SAMPLES: Submit sample of one Type SGNL snow guard as requested.

1.03 QUALITY ASSURANCE:

- A. INSTALLER: Installer is to be experienced in the installation of specified roofing material and snow guards for not less than 5 years in the area of the project.
- B. FASTENERS: Not necessary.
- C. CODE COMPLIANCE: Comply with all applicable local, state, and national building codes, as well as OSHA regulations.
- D. STORAGE: Boxes containing Gough SnoGuards should be stored in a dry place until ready for use.
